IMPORTANT NOTICE — PLEASE READ CAREFULLY. These Terms and Conditions constitute a legally binding agreement between you (the "User" or "you") and Continent Times LLC ("Continent Times," "we," "us," or "our"). By accessing or using the website located at <https://www.continenttimes.com> (the "Site"), you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions and all applicable laws and regulations. If you do not agree to these Terms, you must immediately discontinue your use of the Site.

1. Introduction & Acceptance of Terms

1.1 Agreement to Terms. These Terms and Conditions (the "Terms") govern your access to and use of the Site operated by Continent Times LLC, a limited liability company organized and existing under the laws of the District of Columbia, United States. Continent Times LLC publishes an online news platform covering Politics, Business, and Financial News and related subject matter. By visiting, browsing, registering, or otherwise using any portion of the Site, you expressly agree to be legally

bound by these Terms, our Privacy Policy (available at <https://www.continenttimes.com/privacy-policy/>), and any other policies or guidelines incorporated herein by reference.

1.2 Discontinuation of Use. If you do not agree to any of the provisions set forth in these Terms, you must immediately cease all access to and use of the Site. Your continued use of the Site following the posting of any revised or updated Terms constitutes your binding acceptance of those changes. It is your responsibility to review these Terms periodically to remain informed of any updates.

1.3 Right to Modify Terms. Continent Times LLC reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to modify, amend, update, or replace any portion of these Terms at any time and without prior notice. When changes are made, we will update the "Last Updated" date appearing at the top of this page. We may, but are not obligated to, provide additional notice of material changes via a notice posted on the Site or communicated by other reasonable means. Your continued access to or use of the Site after any modifications have been posted constitutes your acceptance of and agreement to be bound by the revised Terms.

1.4 Scope of Agreement. These Terms apply to all visitors, registered users, subscribers, contributors, and any other persons who access or use the Site in any manner, whether as a guest or as a registered account holder. You shall not use the Site in any manner that could violate any applicable law or regulation, infringe upon the rights of any third party, or expose Continent Times LLC to legal liability.

It is the policy of Continent Times LLC to respond expeditiously to claims of copyright infringement that comply with the Digital Millennium Copyright Act of 1998 (the "DMCA"), codified at 17 U.S.C. § 512.

4.2 DMCA Takedown Notice — Required Information. to permit Continent Times LLC to locate the material on the Site (e.g., the URL or specific page address where the material appears);

4. Information reasonably sufficient to permit Continent Times LLC to contact you, the complaining party, including your name, address, telephone number, and, if available, an email address;
5. A statement that you have a good faith belief that use of the material in the manner complained of is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law; and
6. A statement that the information in the notification is accurate, and under penalty of perjury, that you are the copyright owner or authorized to act on the copyright owner's behalf.

4.3 Submission of DMCA Notice. 4.4 Counter-Notification Procedure.
